To add points to Hebrew letters: Set your Language Bar to Hebrew [Left ALT + SHIFT] and ensure NUMBER Pad is on [press NUM LOCK key.] Type a Hebrew letter or word.

With insertion point to the left of a letter hold down the Left ALT key, type the code using the Number Pad on the Right of your keyboard, then release ALT.
